For those who meet our medical criteria, we provide trained exit guides, free of charge, to provide in-home education on safe, comfortable methods of self-deliverance and a compassionate presence at the end for those who choose that option.

We serve in all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

Those applying for Exit Guide Services must be competent adults who are physically able to perform the necessary actions themselves. We do not provide physical assistance or the means.

Means of Self-Deliverance

Working with NuTech and Exit International, Final Exit Network is researching safe, reliable, physically accessible methods of self-deliverance, so that individuals may choose to end their lives comfortably at home without having to rely on death-with-dignity laws or the medical system.

Psychosocial Issues

We are aware that the human experience is complex and that simply offering pain control does not begin to answer the needs of those who would shape their final chapter based on their own values, experience, and priorities. Working with our clients, we seek to provide a more nuanced picture of why people choose to conclude their lives before they have to.

Those who choose to actively end their lives before being rendered incompetent by dementia must do so early, when they have the mental ability to carry out their plan. That choice doesn't work for everyone who wishes to avoid years of decline through dementia.

Final Exit Network is working to provide and legally support an advance directive with which a competent individual can specify that their future incompetent self be permitted to stop eating and drinking as a means of hastening their death.

So yes, we loved Mom enough to support her in this wish. Though, of course, we miss her terribly.
